Leagues for 2014/2015:

Daytime Mixed League on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 10:30 and 1:00:

Coordinated by Bert Carswell. Curlers of all levels are welcome to join this league. This is a 2 draw a week league with curlers invited to register for the entire season (2 leagues) or either the Fall (Oct - Dec) or Winter (Jan - Mar) league.

Monday Night Open League at 7:15:

Coordinated by Juanita Wannamaker. If you are an experienced curler, this league may be what you are looking for. Competitive play in a friendly environment with teams made up of any combination of curlers.

Tuesday Night Women's League at 7:15:

Coordinated by Joy Hill. All female curlers, including novice and non-curlers are welcome to join this friendly league. Balanced teams are formed based on skill level.

Wednesday Mixed League at 7:15:
